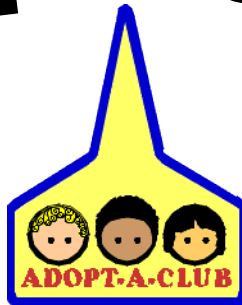


Adopt-a-Club



Imagine that you're a Pastor or Missionary in Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe, or South America. You know Awana is an effective tool for reaching the children in your area. Yet neither their church, nor the children's families have enough **money** for Awana materials. Without support from somewhere else, Awana Clubs in these and other areas simply would not survive. That's where **Adopt-a-Club** makes a world of difference.

Adopt-a-Club links Awana Clubs and individuals in North America with needy Awana Clubs elsewhere around the world. Here's how it works: Clubs and families in North America agree to sponsor an international club. The sponsor contributes money that enables the sponsored club to purchase essential Awana materials such as handbooks, uniforms, and awards.

Interested in **Adopt-a-Club** sponsorship? **Camarillo Community Church** has:

- **Boys** Club at **Iglesia La Neuva** in Jerusalem, Equador.
- **Girls** Club at **Bosmont Evangelical Bible Church** in South Africa

For this purpose your child will be given a coin bank. When this bank is full of Quarters (**\$5.00 US**) bring it to club the first club night of the month (**AC** on schedule), hand it to the Secretaries at the front desk, give the receipt to Club Director.

For helping as an Adopt-a-Club sponsor the first year, we will award a special **Adopt-a-Club** Sponsorship Patch (*shown above*) that may be sewn (or ironed-on) to the Awana Uniform. Then after that, **Coin Banks** handed in each year after that will be awarded with a **Childs Face Pin** (*three are shown above*) then a Cross (*goes on the top of the Church Steeple*).
