To show us we need a <u>Savior</u> .	2:3
<b>Acts 4:12</b> – Nor is there <u>salvation</u> in any other, for there is no other name [Jesus] under heaven given among men by which we must be <u>saved</u> .	
So we can know how to <u>live</u> .	2:5
<b>Psalms 86:11</b> – Teach me Your <u>way</u> , O LORD; I will <u>walk</u> in Your truth; unite my heart to <u>fear</u> Your name.

<b>Genesis 1:1</b> – In the <u>beginning</u> God <u>created</u> the heavens and the earth.	
God is eternal – the <u>beginning</u> and the <u>end</u> .	3:4
<b>Revelation 22:13</b> – “I am the <u>Alpha</u> and the <u>Omega</u> , the <u>Beginning</u> and the <u>End</u> , the First and the Last.”	
God is <u>just</u> .	3:5
<b>Isaiah 45:21b-22</b> – And there is no other God <u>besides</u> Me, a <u>just</u> God and a Savior; there is none <u>besides</u> Me. Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.	
God is <u>holy</u> (without sin).	3:6
<b>Psalms 99:3</b> – Let them <u>praise</u> Your great and awesome <u>name</u> – He is <u>holy</u> .
