Church is a place where I can serve.	1 Timothy 4:12 – Let no one <i>despise</i> your youth, but be an example to the <i>believers</i> in word, in <i>conduct</i> , in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.	4:2
Church is a place where I can give my offering.	2 Corinthians 9:7 – So let each one give as he <i>purposes</i> in his heart, not <i>grudgingly</i> or of <i>necessity</i> ; for God loves a cheerful giver.	4:5
Church is a place where I remember Christ's death and resurrection in a special way.	Luke 22:19-20 – And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new <i>covenant</i> in My blood, which is shed for you."	4:6

Why is it important to have Christian friends? - To encourage one another.	4:1
If you have trusted Christ as Savior, then you are old enough to serve Him. People are watching your attitude and actions. Set a good example for others to follow.	4:2
An offering is a gift of money we offer to God.	4:5
God doesn't care how much we give. He cares why we give.	
When we are cheerful givers, we are showing God that we love Him.	
Why did the Lord Jesus Christ die on the cross? - To save us from our sins. .	4:6
Why is it important to know that He rose again? Because someone who is dead cannot give life to another, Someone who is dead cannot love us and take care of us.	
One way to remember what the Lord Jesus has done is through communion (sometimes called the Lord's supper). During communion, we are served bread to remind us how the Lord Jesus' body was nailed to the cross. We drink the juice to remember that the Lord Jesus shed His blood for our sins. Communion is one way to remember the Savior's never-ending love for us.	
Another way to remember the Lord is through baptism by immersion. Baptism by immersion means being put under the water and being brought back up out of the water, and it's a picture of Christ's death, burial and resurrection.
