<b>The Bible is God's <u>Word</u></b>		
<b>Jeremiah 10:10a</b> - But the LORD is the <u>true</u> God; He is the <u>living</u> God.		<b>1:1</b>
<b>John 17:17b</b> - Your word is <u>truth</u>		
<b>Psalms 119:42b</b> - I <u>trust</u> in Your word.		
<b>God says His Word is <u>pure</u>.</b>		
<b>Proverbs 30:5-6</b> Every word of God is <u>pure</u> ; He is a shield to those who put their <u>trust</u> in Him. Do not add to His words, lest He <u>rebuke</u> you and you be found a liar.		<b>1:3</b>
<b>People <u>witnessed</u> the events of the Bible.</b>		
<b>2 Peter 1:16</b> – For we did not follow <u>cunningly devised fables</u> when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were <u>eyewitnesses</u> of His <u>majesty</u> .		<b>1:4</b>
<b>1 John 1:1</b> - That which was from the beginning [Christ], which we have <u>heard</u> , which we have seen with our <u>eyes</u> , which we have looked upon and our hands have handled, concerning the <u>Word</u> of life.		
<b>The Bible is <u>historically correct</u>.</b>		
<b>1 John 1: 2</b> - ...The life was <u>manifested</u> , and we have seen and bear <u>witness</u> , and declare to you that <u>eternal</u> life which was with the Father and was <u>manifested</u> to us.		<b>1:6</b>

## Book 3 Challenge 2

### How Do We Know the Bible is True?

<b>God used at least <u>40</u> men to write the Bible – and yet it all fits together.</b>		
<b>Luke 1:1-2, 4</b> – <i>Inasmuch</i> as many have taken in hand to <i>set in order a narrative</i> of those things which have been fulfilled among us. Just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word <i>delivered</i> them to us. That you may know the <i>certainty</i> of those things in which you were instructed.		2:2
<b>The Bible was written over a time period of <u>1500</u> years and yet it all fits together.</b>		
<b>Romans 16:26</b> - But now has been made <i>manifest</i> , and by the prophetic Scriptures has been made known to all nations, according to the commandment of the <i>everlasting</i> God, for obedience to the faith.		2:3
<b>2 Peter 1:21</b> - For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the <i>Holy Spirit</i> .		
<b>Events that were <u>prophesied</u> really happened.</b>		
<b>Jeremiah 28:9</b> – As for the <i>prophet</i> who <i>prophesies</i> of peace, when the word of the <i>prophet</i> comes to pass, the <i>prophet</i> will be known as one whom the LORD has truly sent.		2:4
<b>Deuteronomy 18:22</b> – When a <i>prophet</i> speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the <i>prophet</i> has spoken it <i>presumptuously</i> ; you shall not be afraid of him.		
<b>The Bible changes people's <u>lives</u>.</b>		
<b>Acts 16:30-31</b> - And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be <u>saved</u> ?" So they said, " <u>Believe</u> on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be <u>saved</u> , you and your household."		2:6

## Book 3 Challenge 3

### What do I need to know about God?

<b>God offers me the <u>ultimate gift</u></b>	
<b>Ephesians 2:8-10</b> – For by <u>grace</u> you have been saved through <u>faith</u> , and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God. Not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are <i>His workmanship</i> , created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should <u>walk</u> in them.	3:2
<b>God wants me to <u>honor Him</u>.</b>	
<b>Exodus 20:3-5a</b> – You shall have no other gods before Me. You shall not make for yourself a <u>carved image</u> - any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them nor <u>serve</u> them.	3:4
<b>Exodus 20:7a, 8</b> – You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in <u>vain</u> . Remember the <u>Sabbath</u> day, to keep it holy.	
<b>God wants me to <u>honor my family and neighbors</u>.</b>	
<b>Exodus 20:12-15</b> – <u>Honor</u> your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you. You shall not murder. You shall not commit <u>adultery</u> . You shall not steal.	3:5
<b>Exodus 20:16-17</b> – You shall not <u>bear</u> false witness against your neighbor. You shall not <u>covet</u> your neighbor's house. You shall not <u>covet</u> your neighbor's wife, or his male servant nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's.	
<b>God is <u>merciful</u>.</b>	
<b>Romans 3:20</b> – Therefore by the <u>deeds</u> of the law no flesh will be <u>justified</u> in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.	3:6
<b>Titus 3:5</b> – Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His <u>mercy</u> He <u>saved</u> us, through the <u>washing of regeneration</u> and renewing of the Holy Spirit.	
<b>Romans 3:28</b> – Therefore we conclude that a man is <u>justified</u> by faith apart from the <u>deeds</u> of the law.

<b>Mark 12:30</b> And you shall love the LORD your God with all your <u>heart</u> , with all your <u>soul</u> , with all your <u>mind</u> and with all your <u>strength</u> . This is the first commandment.	3:7

### What do I need to know about God?

<b>God is <u>faithful</u>.</b>		
<b>1 Corinthians 1:9</b> – God is <u>faithful</u> , by whom you were called into the <u>fellowship</u> of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.		4:2
<b>1 Corinthians 10:13</b> – No <u>temptation</u> has overtaken you except such as <u>is common to man</u> ; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the <u>temptation</u> will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to <u>bear it</u> .		
<b>God <u>loves</u> the world.</b>		
<b>John 5:24</b> – <u>Most assuredly</u> , I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into <u>judgment</u> , but has passed from death into life.		4:3
<b>God is my <u>authority</u>.</b>		
<b>Matthew 28:18</b> – And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All <u>authority</u> has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.”		4:5
<b>Philippians 2:9-10</b> – Therefore God also has highly <u>exalted</u> Him and given Him the name which is above every name. That at the name of Jesus <u>every knee should bow</u> , of those in heaven, and of those on earth and of those under the earth.		
<b>God <u>cares</u> about me.</b>		
<b>Luke 12:6-7</b> – Are not five <u>sparrows</u> sold for <u>two copper coins</u> ? And not one of them is forgotten before God. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many <u>sparrows</u> .		4:6
<b>1 Peter 5:7</b> – <u>Cast</u> all your <u>care</u> upon Him, for He cares for you.		
<b>Hebrews 13:5</b> – Let <u>your conduct</u> be without <u>covetousness</u> ; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.”
